

Question 1:

We experienced problems with the IRDA (infra-red detector assembly) board on two machines, one during early voting and the other on Election Day. In both cases the machines were removed from the sites and taken to our Election Center facility where the boards were replaced. Once completed the machines were returned to their respective early voting site or precinct.

On Election Day we also had approximately 12 machines that had problems with "white screens". We believe there is a problem on some of the machines where the machine is not getting power from the outside power supply (standard outlet and/or power cords) at the point of entry into the units themselves, thereby relying on battery power to operate and running the batteries down. We think this is the problem because all of our batteries were replaced prior to the general election.

We have discussed this with our vendor and will be looking into it further with them to see if our assumptions are correct and what we need to do to correct the problem.

In each case the iVotronic was closed and taken out of service until the polls closed. The votes on these machines were gathered along with the other units prior to submitting results from the precincts on election night.
